



Frequently Asked Questions

- ***“How much credit can I receive through Baker University for my Insurance License(s)?”***

The amount of credit awarded depends on the type of license that you hold. Individual Insurance Licenses are worth 3 credits. Combined Insurance Licenses are also worth 3 credits. You can only receive credit for a license once, even if you hold the same license in more than one state. A listing of Insurance Licenses accepted by Baker University and their credit equivalents is available on our partnership website, www.adbcollegecredit.com, under “Exam Prep Course Listing.”

- ***“How much credit can I receive through Baker University for my Securities License(s)?”***

The amount of credit awarded depends on the type of license that you hold. The credits awarded per license varies from 1.5 credits to 4.5 credits each. You can reference the “Exam Prep Course List” on our partnership website, www.adbcollegecredit.com, for a listing of Securities Licenses that we accept and their credit equivalents.

- ***“Can I also receive credit for my Continuing Education courses?”***

Yes! Baker University will award credit for both Classroom and Self-Study courses, for almost 150 different courses. The credits awarded per course varies from .5 credits to 3 credits. - ***“How much does it cost?”***

The cost to receive credit through Baker University is \$100.00 per credit hour. This applies to both Licenses and Continuing Education Courses. There are no registration or application fees.

- ***“Is graduate level credit available?”***

Only undergraduate level credit is available through Baker University.

- ***“Can I receive college credit for Continuing Education Courses that I have already completed?”***
