Baker University Student Senate Election Guidelines

1. Petitions
 - Candidates will be required to obtain 30 signatures from students in **their class** and answer the attached questions to the best of their ability.

2. Campaigning
 - Campaign signs are allowed with the exception of campus computer labs.
 - Candidates shall use decorum and be appropriate in all any campaign materials.

3. Polling Stations
 - The voting process will be strictly confidential. Electronic polling will be used to cast and decide votes. The election voting link will be sent to all students via Baker email.
