

Basic Summary of Changes:

1. **NO** PNMs are allowed to be in the chapter houses between the time of tours on move in-day and the first day of recruitment (aka: the first week of school)
2. All PNMs may sign up for recruitment up until the start of the first round on Wednesday. Meaning that PNMs will be required to attend Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of formal recruitment in order to receive a bid card.
3. **Open House Tours**- tours open for two days.
 - Each PNM will have a “passport” and will be encouraged to have all four houses “stamped”.
 - Chapters may use chalk on sidewalks of their property, as well as put up posters on their property, to advertise their chapter during house tours. (Sunday & Monday ONLY) These posters must be removed & chalk washed off before Tuesday.
4. **Panhellenic Unity Night on Tuesday Night**
 - This event is to show the PMNs the importance of Greek Unity on Baker’s campus.
 - This will be held in a neutral place (most likely cafeteria) and will basically go as follows:

All participants receive a slip of paper as they walk into the cafeteria. The station written on the paper will be where each person will be located. This is how we plan to mix girls up, to show diversity and pure Greek unity. A project will be chosen for a philanthropy not tied to any Panhellenic chapter on Baker’s campus. All girls will work together to create the project and get to know one another in a laid-back and philanthropic setting.

*this service project will be decided at a later date and Chapter members will be informed as soon as the decision is made.
 - All-Panhellenic Philanthropy shirts worn to Panhellenic Unity Night Event. The shirts will all have the same design (simple cute saying on front, all four philanthropies on back) and will be different color (each chapter different color, Panhellenic Exec./Gamma Chi’s/PNM’s another color).
