MINOR AREA OF CONCENTRATION

2011-2012 Baker University Catalog

Students wishing to minor in a given discipline must meet the minor requirements outlined by that department in the catalog. If specific courses required for a minor are not designated by a given department, a minimum of 12 semester hours of course work in that department, 3 of which must be numbered 300 or above, is required for a minor.

ACCOUNTING - AC141, AC142, EC242 (all three courses must be completed with a grade of 'C-' or higher); and 6 additional hours in accounting.

ART - 15 hours in art, including AE110, AH 111, AH 495 and any two AS courses.

ART HISTORY – AH111, AH495, and 6 additional hours in art history, 3 of which must be upper-college.

BIOLOGY – Two biology courses at the 100-200 level, each of which must have a laboratory component. Two biology courses at the 300-level, one of which must be a lab course. All courses for the minor must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher. Students must submit a plan for the minor to the department chair for approval.

BUSINESS - AC141, BS141, EC242, and 6 additional credit hours from the following: BS251, BS271, BS353, BS355, BS381 (all except BS355 must be completed with a grade of 'C-' or higher).

CHEMISTRY - CH137, CH138, CH140, CH251, CH252, and three credit hours of upper-college work in chemistry.

CHURCH SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP – Listening to your Inner Voice: Vocation and Career (Interterm course), an approved lower-college internship experience (II255 or CI260), an approved upper-college internship experience (II355 or CI360), and at least six credit hours in one of the following five focus areas. Focus Area 1 – Church Financial Management: AC141, BS141, BS 353 or BS 355. Focus Area 2 – Teaching and Learning in the Church: ED345, ED380 or PY243. Focus Area 3 – Media Technology and the Church: MM140, MM230 or MM250. Focus Area 4 – Church Music Education: MU126, MU127, MU151, MU153, MU244, MU246, MU264, or MU463. Focus Area 5 – Church and Society: HI346, SO243, SO337 or SO363

COACHING – HP182, HP244, HP245, HP348 and HP420. (Students majoring in Sports Administration are not eligible for this minor.)

COMMUNICATION - CO242, CO245, CO257, and two upper college communication courses.

COMPUTER SCIENCE - CS175, CS185, CS223, and two of the following courses: CS226, CS335, CS341, CS371, CS392. At least one course must be numbered 300 or above.

CONFLICT MANAGEMENT – CO242, CO257 and CO337, along with three hours from the following: CO237, CO355, CO467, and three additional hours from the following: EC151, PY385, SO346, SO380.

ECONOMICS - EC242, EC243, EC346 (all three courses must be completed with a grade of 'C-' or higher); and 6 additional hours in economics. (If used for the minor, EC400 and EC464 must be completed with a grade of 'C-' or higher.)

EXERCISE SCIENCE – One of the following courses: BI246, BI360, BI382; all of the following courses: HP182, HP244, HP 343 and HP 347. (Students majoring in Exercise Science or Health/Physical Education Teaching are not eligible for this minor.)

ENGLISH - 15 hours in English to include: EN204, 3 additional hours at the 200-level or above, and 3 hours of upper-college credit. **EN100 (English Composition courses) and EN262 do not count toward the minor.**

FRENCH - 12 hours in French at the 204-level or above of which 3 hours must be upper-college.

GERMAN - 12 hours in German at the 204-level or above of which 3 hours must be upper-college.

HISTORY - 15 hours of history courses: 1) 6 hours from HI140, HI141, HI142, HI143; 2) HI127 or HI128; 3) one of the following: HI261, HI333, HI334, HI335, HI346, HI348; 4) 3 additional hours of upper-college history.

MASS MEDIA – MM140, MM250, MM251, MM331 (a grade of "C" or higher is required in all 4 of the previously listed courses); and three additional hours of upper college mass media. (If used for the minor, MM 376, MM476 and MM478 must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher.)

MATHEMATICS - MA171 and MA172 and two courses from the following: MA271, MA281, MA291, courses numbered MA300 or above (excluding MA321, MA330 & MA345). At least one math course must be numbered 300 or above.

MUSIC - Requirements in two areas: 1) <u>Music Theory & History</u>: MU151, MU153, MU157, MU164, MU331 or MU332. 2) <u>Music Performance</u>: Applied Private Lessons-MU2XX/MU4XX(4 hrs), must pass Achievement Level I by jury examination, and Large Music Ensembles-MU2XX/MU4XX (4 hrs).

PHILOSOPHY - 12 hours in philosophy, 3 of which must be upper-college.

PHYSICS - PC225, PC226, and one upper-level physics course.

PSYCHOLOGY - 15 hours in psychology at any level.

RELIGION - 12 hours in religion, 3 of which must be upper-college.

SOCIAL JUSTICE – SJ210 & SJ493; two Source courses selected from the following: AH250, CO420, EC111, EN226, HI333, HI334, HI348, PS212, SO243, SO329, SO330, SO331, SO410; two Solutions courses selected from the following: CO257, CO355, CO467, EC151, PH/PS310, SO337.

SOCIOLOGY - SO115, one 200-level course, two courses numbered 300 or above, and one additional sociology course numbered 200 or above.

SPANISH - 12 hours in Spanish at the 204-level or above of which 3 must be upper-college.

THEATRE - TH111, TH130, TH145, TH320 or TH330, TH280 or TH123 and three additional hours of theatre.
