

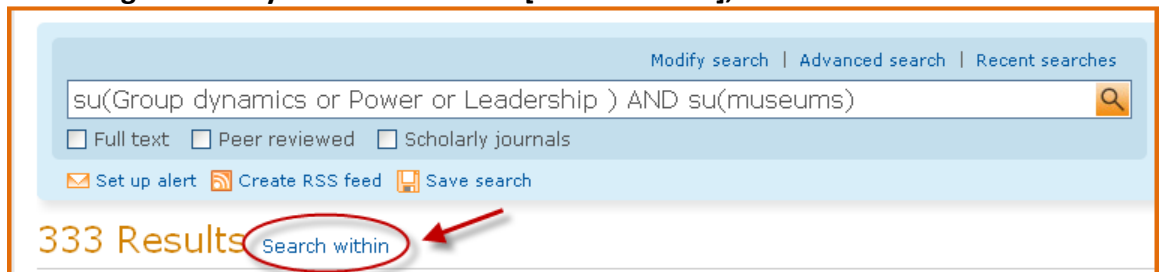

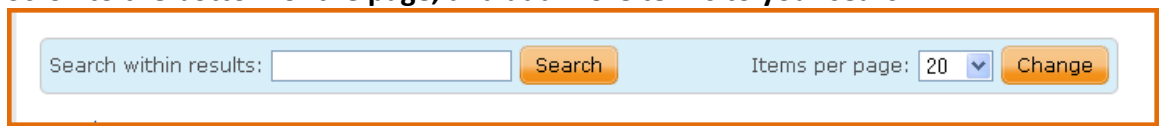

- Searching “within” your results. Select [Search within],

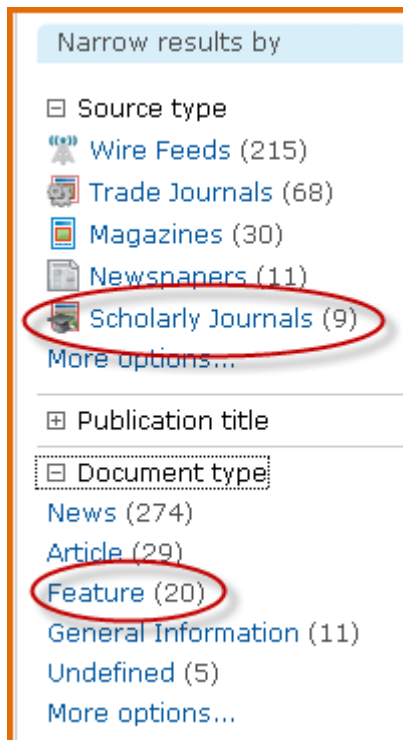


- Scroll to the bottom of the page, and add more terms to your search.




You can also keep narrowing your results by:






