

In accordance with the Department of Education FAFSA Simplification Act, all institutions of higher education are required to share the cost of attendance (COA) to include Tuition, fees, housing, meals, transportation, personal expenses, and books. The COA is an estimate of all reasonable expenses a family can expect. The COA is not the actual charges the student will see on their student account. The COA is an estimate of what it might cost an average student to attend. Actual costs will vary based on individual choices in residence hall options, meal plans, and courses.
