Homecoming 2024 Candidate Rules

Homecoming Royalty is an important and visible role at Baker University. The Royalty represent all the best of Baker University. As such, these students will be held to a high standard of Baker University's values & mission. Please be sure to read and understand the following entire packet of rules, schedules, and procedures.

1. The Homecoming Royalty Competition consists of one division of Baker University students who were nominated and then applied. All registered student organizations may nominate one candidate.
2. Each organization or activity on campus can sponsor a candidate. If a candidate has already been nominated by another organization, please select another candidate to represent your organization or activity.
3. Each candidate must submit the application form and digital photo by **11:59 PM on Friday, September 6** to be eligible for selection.
4. The Top 10 candidates will be selected by a committee made up of staff and faculty from across the Baldwin City campus. The decision will be made based on the application the candidate submits.
5. The Top 10 candidates may campaign upon being selected until the closing of voting. Campaign guidelines are listed on page 2 of this packet.
6. The final Royalty decision will be made by electronic vote that opens Monday, September 16 at 8:00am during Homecoming Week and ending Thursday September 19 at 4:30pm. No staff or faculty are eligible to vote in that election.
7. Three members of the court will be selected during the student voting. These Royalty members will be presented during the halftime ceremony at the Homecoming football game on September 21, 2024.
8. In case of a tie, the determining factor will be the candidates' GPAs. Thus the candidate with the higher cumulative GPA would be declared Homecoming Royalty.

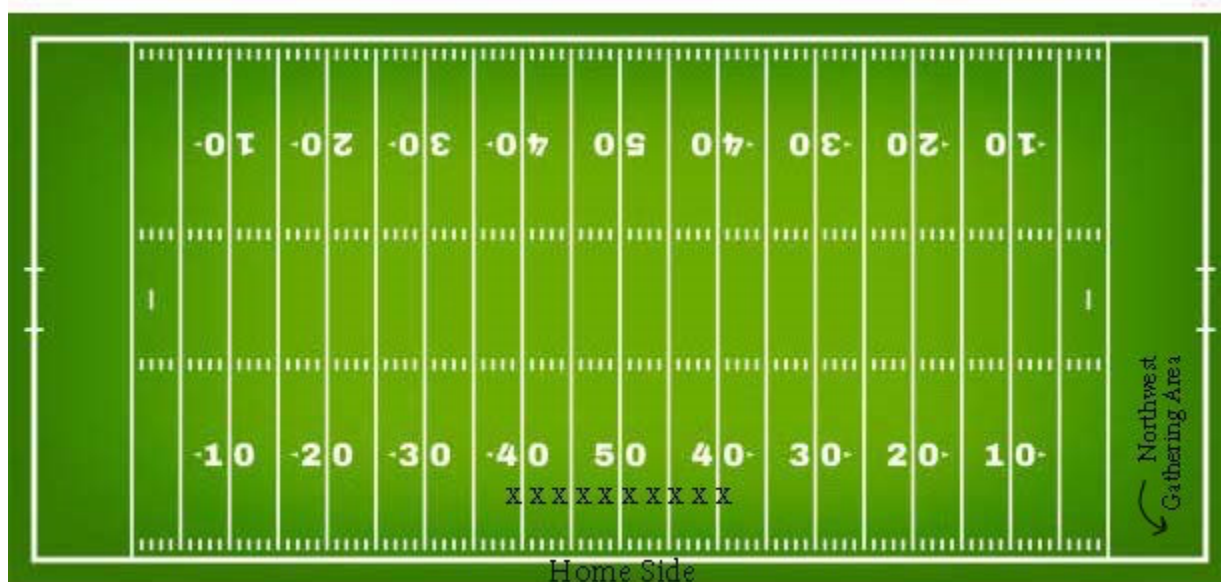
