Educational Engagement *(Highlights of community events and programs)*

14 FSL leaders attended the MIAA Greek Leadership Retreat at Northwest Missouri State University. The group engaged with over 50 students from 7 different campuses during educational workshops. Baker was the smallest school to attend, but brought the largest delegation. Hannah Greer presented at the Association for Fraternal Leadership and Values National Conference in Indianapolis. Her presentation was titled "What's Your Make Up? College-Aged Women's Views of Themselves and How Sororities Can Help."
