Writing Center

Students using this service meet one-on-one with a peer tutor for additional feedback and consultation at any stage of the writing process. Peer tutor conferences are interactive, so students should come ready to discuss their own writing. While students and tutors work together to help strengthen writing, students are still responsible for producing their own work. Writing tutors are available for drop-in sessions during scheduled hours.

Writing tutors will...

- Discuss ideas for new assignments
- Ask guiding questions to help students develop ideas
- Provide feedback on global issues such as focus, organization, logic, and clarity
- Discuss strategies for revising drafts
- Identify patterns of grammatical errors
- Model and provide examples of writing processes
- Refer students to additional writing resources
- Help students develop confidence in a personal writing process
- Talk about documentation conventions

Writing tutors will not...

- Correct errors for students
- Provide editing services
- Do homework for students
- Discuss or in any way guarantee potential assignment grades
