Cohort 19 graduated 8 candidates for the Master of Science in Special Education (MSSE) program on December 14, 2025. Of the eight graduates, one received passing Praxis results on January 9, 2026, and four received passing Praxis results by March 6, 2026. It should be noted that the combined Baker mean was 179.60 which was higher than the state of Kansas mean of 172.08 and the national mean of 168.44. Passing the exam allows each candidate to meet licensing requirements, Baker reviews these pass rates during data review sessions.
